OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Rester moved to approve the award for the East Pier Fender Replacement Project to Walters Diving and Marine. Walters Diving and Marine had the lowest and best bid of five bidders at \$2,417,320.00. Commissioner Norris seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Roberts joined the meeting via telephone.

Commissioner Knesal moved to approve the award for the Site Security Project to Drace Construction. Drace Construction had the lowest and best bid of 3 bidders at \$1,774,884.27. Commissioner Rester seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

Commissioner Norris moved to approve Agreement No. 018-EX-10 between Dole Fresh Fruit and MSPA with a not to exceed amount of \$40,000. Commissioner Knesal seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Rester moved to approve a Purchase and Sale Agreement between the Trust for Public Land, the MS State Port Authority and the Mississippi Development Authority. The total purchase price for both properties is the appraised value of \$1,640,500 and this purchase was required as part of the EIS. Commissioner Norris seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Rester moved to adjourn. Commissioner Knesal seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.
