Commissioner Norris moved to approve the following progress payments: Balch & Bingham (\$51,031.05) and Digital Engineering (\$98,510.75). Commissioner Rester seconded, and the motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Norris moved to approve Cash Request #281 to CH2MHill (\$36,362.20); Eley Guild Hardy (\$59,053.75); MSPA (\$18,364.67) and Wharton Smith (\$1,066,772.28) for a total of \$1,180,552.90. Commissioner Simpson seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Commissioner Simpson moved to award a professional service agreement to Southern Earth Sciences for Construction Materials Testing Services. The agreement will be for a 3 three-year period and total costs not to exceed \$300,000.00 (\$100,000.00 per year is anticipated). Commissioner Rester seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Rester moved to approve Amendment No. 19 with CH2MHill under contract No. 518-C. This Amendment increases costs by \$200,000.00 for program management services related to the Ocean Enterprise Facility, the channel deepening/widening project and the design of the tugboat berth. There is no change in schedule. Commissioner Norris seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Rester moved to approve an Extension to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment to the Lease Agreement with an Option to Purchase with Hancock Whitney Bank. This extends the term of the lease and corresponding period of the option to purchase by six months to June 30, 2021 and has an effective date of 12/17/20. Commissioner Simpson seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Rester moved to approve Modification No. 1 to Contract No. 19-OP-03 with Weaver Electric. This modification allows Weaver electric to acquire items on behalf of MSPA, with values of less than \$500. Commissioner Simpson seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Commissioner Simpson moved to approve Task Order No. 2 under Contract No. 19-EN-05 with Jacobs Engineering. Task Order No. 2 has a not to exceed amount of \$49,436.00. Commissioner Rester seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Rester moved to authorize the advertisement and solicitation of proposals for Investment Advisory Services. Commissioner Norris seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Rester moved to authorize the advertisement and solicitation of proposals for copier services. Commissioner Simpson seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Rester moved to authorize the disposition of various salvage items. Commissioner Simpson seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.
